SWITCH OF MASS ROTA FROM SEPTEMBER: To give parishioners the opportunity to attend a different weekend Mass a new rota is being introduced. Weekend of the 5/6 September it will be parishioners from near Ballymaguigan for the vigil & Derrygarve, Aughrim Road, Airfield Road & Bannside for the, 10am Sunday Mass. Weekend of 12/13 September we invite those parishioners in Creagh Road and beyond, to border of Bellaghy (excluding Bannside) to attend the vigil Mass. Those from Ballymaguigan who live beyond St Trea's school to attend the Sunday Mass 10am. Volunteers to steward and clean are to be provided by the area attending. We are grateful for those who have already helped especially new volunteers and young people.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holydays remains suspended.

In order to support the **NHS TEST AND TRACE PROGRAMME**, we are taking contact details (name and telephone number) for all worshippers, as well as recording times (apart from weekend Masses) entering and leaving St Treas Church. Please note this applies to all weekday Masses and private prayer.
