WEEKEND MASSES: (limited numbers) Saturday 7pm & Sunday 10am

WEEKDAY MASSES: 10am (except Monday 10am & 7pm)

CONFESSIONS: Saturday 5pm

ROSARY: **7pm. Or at a time of your choice.** All are invited to pray for protection from Covid 19.

FEAST OF ALL SAINTS. **Sunday 1st November.** A special ceremony dedicating the month to the memory of the dead will take place in the church Sunday at 3pm. Crosses will remain at the altar throughout the month. We hope to stream the ceremony.

FEAST OF ALL SOULS. Monday 2nd November Mass 10am & 7pm.

Plenary Indulgence for the Holy Souls once per day from 1st to 8 Nov by visiting a graveyard and praying for the dead. Usual conditions apply (attending confessions within a week and receiving Holy Communion on the day and praying for the Pope's intentions.)

CHURCH OPEN: for private prayer (during pandemic) during daylight hours.

FACE COVERINGS are a normal feature of life now. They should be worn at all ceremonies in the Church. (exceptions are those who are medically exempt).

NHS TEST AND TRACE PROGRAMME: thank you for signing the sheets at the door. Records will be held for 21days then destroyed and used only for test & trace.

PUBLIC MASSES: Regulations include cleaning/ sanitising of the Church after each ceremony, observing proper distance – 2m if possible - having stewards.

Sunday 8 November 10am Ballymaguigan beyond St Trea's school.

Saturday 14 November 7pm near Ballymaguigan.

Sunday 15 November 10am Derrygarve, Aughrim Road, Airfield Road & Bannside.

Volunteers to steward and clean are to be provided by the area attending – and by families for their special occasions. (Anniversaries etc.) Extra volunteers especially young people are needed.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holydays remains suspended but those who feel safe are encouraged to be present. Numbers are limited to 25 for funerals and weddings.
