PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR THE HOLY SOULS to be gained once per day by those who visit a cemetery and pray (even if it only mentally) for the deceased. Has been extended to the entire month of November. Usual conditions apply.

FACE COVERINGS are a normal feature of life now. They should be worn at all ceremonies in the Church. (exceptions are those who are medically exempt).

NHS TEST AND TRACE PROGRAMME: thank you for signing the sheets at the door. Records will be held for 21days then destroyed and used only for test & trace.

PUBLIC MASSES: Regulations include cleaning/ sanitising of the Church after each ceremony, observing proper distance – 2m if possible - having stewards.

MASS ROTA:

Saturday 21 Nov 7pm Creagh Road and beyond, to border of Bellaghy.

Sunday 22 November 10am Ballymaguigan beyond St Trea's school.

(Arrangements beyond this will be announced later.)

Volunteers to steward and clean are to be provided by the area attending – and by families for their special occasions. (Anniversaries etc.) Extra volunteers especially young people are needed.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holydays remains suspended but those who feel safe are encouraged to be present. Numbers are limited to 25 for funerals and weddings. Please be careful to observe all directives to protect against Covid 19.

CHURCH HEATING: The contract for the new system has been won by McCorley Mechanical & Electrical. It is hoped to start the work soon. The church will have to be closed, initially on weekdays but, to make possible a Christmas completion, also at weekends. At the moment the church is open for Mass until 22 November. Please note all baptisms need to be arranged before the 22 November.
