MASS next weekend 3 /4 July we invite those parishioners in Derrygarve, Aughrim Road, Airfield, Bannside & Hillhead Road to attend vigil Mass 7pm. Near Ballymaguigan to attend Sunday Mass 10am.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holydays remains suspended. Because of the pandemic, numbers will be restricted to the capacity of the church. We intend to live-stream the main ceremonies. **It is important to work along with the stewards.**

Volunteers to steward and clean should be provided by the area attending. We are grateful for those who have already volunteered but uptake has not been sufficient. Public Mass is not permitted in their absence. Young people and those not shielding are invited to help our parish in this time of need. **Appeal for more stewards** with numbers at the weekend Masses increasing we are seeking volunteers to help people to find a seat.

With schools closing this week we would like to thank teachers and school personnel for their excellent work throughout the pandemic. Good wishes to parents and pupils for the summer break.
