COVID RESTRICTIONS: As infections continue at a very high level, we encourage everybody to be extra vigilant about the standard precautions. Also it is best to avoid Saturday Vigil and Sunday Morning Masses for Months Mind celebrations and 1<sup>st</sup> Anniversaries. Maximum number for wedding and funerals is 70.

Your response, and the responses of various groups and organisations, across the archdiocese, will be very helpful and will contribute greatly to a listening process that is taking place around the world. To help you take part in the process the Synodal Core Group in the Archdiocese of Armagh has organised a virtual consultation that will broadcast twice a day 3pm and 8.30pm, Monday to Friday, from the 7th February to the 25th February on the St. Patrick's Cathedral Webcam.
