**TROCAIRE BOXES:** To be returned. It is a great help if loose coins are changed to notes. Anyone needing a box can collect one at the church porch.

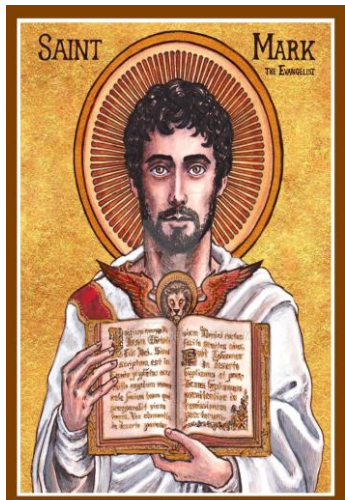
**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION:** Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2026 @ 12noon.

**GRAVEYARD:** Because burial ground in the parish is a very limited resource it is important to use it efficiently. For this reason, it is important that all new graves be deep enough for two coffins (a single grave is double deep). Only when more than two burials in a plot will be required can a double width be allocated. Guidelines can be read in the Church porch or on the parish website.

A Post Box has been installed outside the Parish Centre for requests for anniversaries, late collection envelopes, etc. or these can be brought to the sacristy. (not to the Parochial House).
